We'll have a discussion with DPW about ways to more rapidly improve conditions for active transportation in Burlington. Some particular questions for the discussion:

- With the change in administrations, what is DPW thinking about changing in terms of how it approaches development of active transportation infrastructure?
- What would DPW like to change in order to be more effective and faster in development of active transportation infrastructure? What does DPW need in order to make those changes, and how can BWBC assist you?
- How does DPW respond to crashes?
- Eclipse and Main Street closure retrospective: What can/is DPW learning from these street closures? How can those learnings be applied to how the City operates?
