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Notice of Trespass

This notice is a Warning that you are trespassing and not permitted on the property of the City of Burlington, specifically the BTV Airport, located at 1200 Airport Dr. You must leave these premises immediately. This will remain in effect for 6 months, until March 2025, unless you obtain a waiver or appeal this Notice as detailed below.

I. Reason: This Notice of Trespass is issued because your behavior has been dangerous, illegal, or unreasonably disruptive, and is described as follows:

Verbal altercation, assault/harassment threatened

II. Prior Warning:

- A. Has this person received a warning, informing this person of the basis for this Notice, and been given an opportunity and reasonable amount of time to change or address the underlying conduct, prior to issuance of this Notice? Yes ☐ (if yes, date) No ☒
- B. No warning is required if trespass is based on an accusation of serious harmful conduct (e.g. threats of or actual arson, assault, harassment). Is there alleged serious harmful conduct? Yes ☒ No ☐

III. Enforcement: The consequences for violating the terms of the notice of trespass include:

- A. For a civil violation, pursuant to B.C.O. 21-45 and 24 V.S.A. § 1974a, you may be issued a citation and fined up to \$800.00 for each day you continue to trespass. Is this a civil violation? Yes ☒ No ☐
- B. For a criminal violation, 13 V.S.A. § 3705, the Burlington Police Department may issue you a citation, and you may be arrested for refusal to leave the premises within a reasonable period after issuance. You may be imprisoned up to three (3) months or fined up to \$500.00, or both, if you continue to trespass. Is this a criminal violation? Yes ☐ No ☒

IV. Waiver: You may seek permission (a "waiver") from the City Official to access to this property for purposes of work, residence, accessing government services, or exercising constitutionally protected activities.

IV. Appeal Rights: You may appeal this Notice of Trespass or a denied waiver to the Public Safety Committee pursuant to B.C.O. 21-45A. This must be in writing, delivered (to Attn: Public Safety Committee, City Hall, 149 Church Street, Burlington, VT 05401) within 7 calendar days of the issuance of this Notice; include your name, address, phone number; and indicate whether you are requesting a hearing. Upon filing an appeal, you may reenter the property until there is a hearing and/or a written decision is issued. The Committee will meet within ten (10) business days to consider the appeal. If you do not request a hearing, you may still submit written testimony and evidence. If you do request a hearing, you will be provided at least three (3) business days' written notice of the date, time, and location of the hearing, and you will be allowed to testify verbally or in writing and to produce evidence. The Committee will issue a written decision within ten (10) business days of the hearing.
