As a Peruvian woman living in Vermont, I am launching this venture to share authentic flavors from my culture in an approachable and affordable way. Although this is a new business, it is rooted in my heritage and commitment to quality, consistency, and professional food service. I plan to operate reliably throughout the Marketplace season with a focused, efficient menu that allows me to maintain high standards and contribute something unique to the Church Street community.

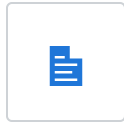

This year, we plan to move away from Church Street Cheesesteaks open as a second location for Kona Beachside (located at North Beach). Our menu consists of fresh ingredients, wild caught fish, and a generally lighter, healthier fare. We believe this will be a welcome change on our block and will help differentiate us from the other vendors by stepping away from heavier, grilled and fried foods. The operations of the cart are backed by our restaurant which has received a great response since opening/rebranding last year, and has been tested at popular events such as Grand Point North and VT Green FC games. 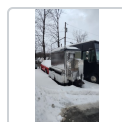

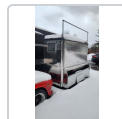

I actually discovered the Cart Vendor Program after seeing those awesome carts in action and Googling how to get involved. The mix of creativity, entrepreneurship, and community engagement felt like a natural fit for what I do.

My brand is built around vibrant, original watercolor artwork transformed into wearable pieces. I create bold, eye-catching apparel that blends Vermont-inspired themes with retro Americana influences, and the line is constantly growing. Every time I complete a new painting, it can become a new garment — meaning the collection is always evolving. I also have new Burlington-focused artwork currently in development that would feel especially at home on Church Street.

I would love the opportunity to bring that color, originality, and local art presence to the Marketplace and be part of the dynamic mix that makes Church Street such a special place.

Please describe your business and cart operation (i.e. what is your business, how long have you been operating, etc.)*

My business centers around original watercolor artwork that I transform into vibrant, wearable pieces. I began selling my artwork on clothing and taking commissioned painting requests in 2020. What started as, “Hey, I wonder if someone would like my new painting on a shirt?” quickly turned into an ever-expanding line of apparel and accessories built entirely around my original art.

Every time I complete a new painting, it has the potential to become a new garment, which means the collection is constantly evolving. My work blends Vermont-inspired themes and local scenes with bold retro Americana influences, resulting in colorful, eye-catching wearable art. I offer clothing, hats, woven blankets, shoes, bolo ties, stickers, and select original framed pieces. I also have new Burlington-focused artwork currently in development that I’m excited to share locally.

For the Cart Vendor Program, I would outfit the cart with hanging bars around the perimeter to display clothing in a clean and accessible way. Above the garment bars, I would incorporate a structured hat display to create strong vertical presence and draw attention from a distance. Beneath and between the hanging apparel, I would feature complementary items such as shoes, woven blankets, bolo ties, stickers, and framed originals. The overall setup would remain compact, organized, and visually dynamic — essentially a small mobile art boutique that adds color and creativity to the Marketplace.

Since 2020, I’ve gained hands-on experience selling directly to customers at markets and events, refining my merchandising, presentation, and customer engagement. I’m confident I can operate successfully within the cart format while bringing a vibrant, locally rooted art presence to Church Street.

For the 2026–2027 season, I plan to operate Tuesday through Sunday from 10:00am – 8:00pm, with flexibility to extend later during peak summer months, Marketplace events, and strong evening foot traffic.

My goal is to maintain a consistent and reliable presence so customers can depend on regular hours while still responding to the natural rhythm of Church Street. My work is visually vibrant and tends to perform especially well with evening strollers and visitors enjoying the Marketplace after dinner, so I am prepared to remain open beyond 8:00pm when pedestrian activity is strong.

I intend to treat the cart as a primary retail presence for the season and align my hours with the energy of the Marketplace to maximize both visibility and accessibility.

Please provide a detailed description of the food/merchandise/goods you plan to sell*

I plan to sell original, artist-designed wearable art and accessories based entirely on my watercolor paintings. Every product begins as a hand-painted original, which I then translate into high-quality apparel and goods.

My merchandise includes vibrant graphic shirts, outerwear, and hats featuring bold, colorful designs that blend Vermont-inspired themes with retro Americana influences. I also offer woven blankets, artist-designed shoes, bolo ties, stickers, and select framed original watercolor paintings. Each piece is rooted in my own artwork — not mass-produced graphics — which gives the collection a distinctive and cohesive visual identity.

The Vermont-inspired pieces celebrate local culture, landscapes, and regional character, while my retro Americana work brings a nostalgic, playful energy that stands out in a busy pedestrian setting. I also have new Burlington-focused artwork currently in development that will be introduced into the apparel line.

Because my inventory expands whenever I create a new painting, the collection is continually evolving. This keeps the merchandise fresh, encourages repeat visits, and allows returning customers to discover something new throughout the season.

Overall, the cart will function as a compact, mobile art boutique — offering colorful, locally rooted, original wearable art that adds visual energy and creativity to Church Street Marketplace.

What are the price ranges for the products you plan to sell?*

My products range from \$3 to approximately \$100+, depending on the item. Smaller items such as stickers begin at \$3, while apparel including shirts and all-over print hats (priced around \$25) fall within an accessible mid-range price point. Larger items such as jackets, woven blankets, and framed original artwork are priced at the higher end of the range.

This structure allows customers to engage with my work at multiple price points — from affordable impulse purchases to statement wearable art and original pieces.

Are the products you use or products you make sourced locally in Vermont?*

Yes. All artwork is originally hand-painted by me in Vermont, and every design begins in my Vermont studio. The creative process — from painting to product development — is entirely Vermont-based.

Several items, including original paintings, bolo ties, earrings, and select accessories, are created and finished by me in Vermont. Some apparel and woven goods are produced through a trusted U.S. production partner in North Carolina after the artwork is completed and designed in Vermont. This partnership allows me to maintain consistency in production while keeping the artistic work and brand rooted locally.

Overall, the heart of the business — the artwork, creative direction, and day-to-day operations — is based in Vermont.

If selected, I plan to either build or commission a custom cart that fully meets Marketplace guidelines. I have access to experienced local woodworkers and fabricators and would collaborate to create a structurally sound, weather-conscious cart with integrated garment bars, elevated hat display, and built-in shelving for accessories and framed artwork. The design would prioritize stability, mobility, and a clean, professional appearance that complements the aesthetic of Church Street. I am prepared to invest in a thoughtfully constructed cart that aligns with program standards and reflects the quality and visual impact of my brand.

Motorized vehicles are only allowed on Church Street from the hours of 7:00am - 10:30am Monday-Saturday. How do you plan to move your cart on and off of Church Street without the use of a vehicle?*

I plan to construct the cart with durable, lockable wheels so it can be safely and efficiently transported without a motorized vehicle. My primary plan would be to park legally on a nearby side street during permitted access hours and manually wheel the cart to and from its designated Marketplace location.

I am also exploring the possibility of incorporating a bicycle-assisted transport design, provided it meets Marketplace guidelines and safety requirements. However, regardless of the final transport method, the cart will be designed to move smoothly, safely, and without disrupting pedestrian traffic.

All load-in and load-out would be handled efficiently and in full compliance with Church Street’s access regulations.

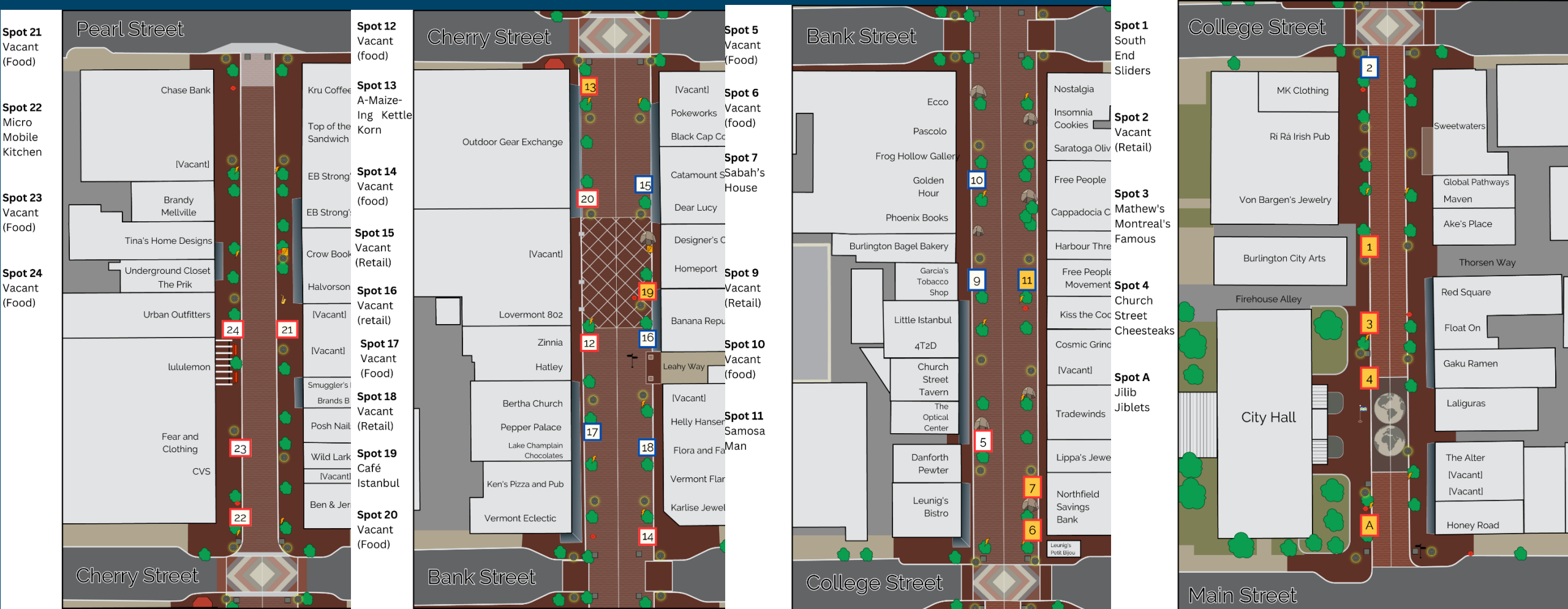
