

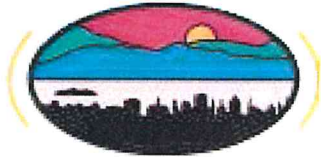

As I described in my initial application, I am a Family Nurse Practitioner experienced in public health and public education. My experiences from working in a multitude of settings, serving people from a variety of backgrounds with many different needs is one of the strongest contributions I bring to the Burlington Board of Health. I have worked in public schools, college health, primary care, urgent care, occupational health, and public health. This has allowed me to care for people with a wide range of primary languages, countries of origin, cultural backgrounds, socio-economic statuses, ages, levels of education, medical complexities, mental health needs and levels of access to and engagement with healthcare. I have held positions both managing statewide public health programs and in a clinic, directly providing healthcare for marginalized populations. I have experience in teaching and facilitating. 

Qualifications for Cemetery Commission

I love Burlington, which has been my home since 2000, when I moved here to join my partner (now, wife).

I've always been drawn to cemeteries, especially old ones, and enjoy walking or jogging through them and stopping to consider the names and lives of the people laid to rest there.

My interest in green burial was strong and immediate when I first learned of it approximately 5-10 years ago through an article about a conservation burial ground in Essex, NY.

For the past several years I have been researching, reading, attending workshops and webinars and developing collegial relationships with various members of the green burial movement, some of whom are recognized nationally. For about a year from 2021 into 2022 I was on a subcommittee of Burlington's Cemetery Commission. We were focused on bringing the option of a green/natural burial to Burlington's cemeteries and while our work was begun, the subcommittee dissolved before our objectives came to fruition.

I was encouraged by current Cemetery Commissioner, Alexandra Millar, to apply for an open seat on the commission and should I be granted the honor of filling it, I would work hard to help Burlington join a growing number of Vermont municipalities which currently run "Hybrid" Burial Grounds, wherein natural burials are permitted as well as conventional burials. At last count, seven towns permit them: East Calais, Plainfield, Corinth, North Hero, Montpelier, Glover, and Brattleboro.

I've made personal connections with cemeterians who incorporate green burial in their cemeteries, and one – Patrick Healy in Montpelier – has offered to talk to Burlington and answer any questions we may have.

I maintain a growing email list of people interested in green death practices, which currently has 125 people in Chittenden County. I offer workshops on this topic several times a year, and observe firsthand people's interest in simple, natural methods of bodily disposition. Thankfully, our state statutes permit this.

With Burlington's goal of moving swiftly towards carbon neutrality, and many citizens who care about mitigating climate change and living lightly on the land, I think Burlington is ripe to become the next Vermont city that permits green burials and I would be excited, dedicated, and honored to help bring about that change.

As a Green Mountain Transit board member, I hope to work to make sure the agency can provide timely and frequent bus service as ridership recovers after COVID. GMT can play a critical role in helping Burlington and the other communities it serves replace single-rider car trips with public transit — and in serving the parts of our communities where fewer households have access to a car. But to do that, service needs to be predictable and reliable, with service changes and delays communicated promptly. Particularly for trips that don't start or end downtown — say, from the South End to the New North End or Winooski — a trip may take three to five times longer than the same trip by car (and in the evening, even longer).

I also hope to advocate for GMT to use special events to communicate services to a broad range of potential riders. What I hope to accomplish as a Commissioner:

I am the mother of a young adult with serious mental health challenges, resulting in multiple police interactions for over 10 years when my son was in crisis. During this time, I have seen many reports of people in crisis or dealing with mental health challenges, of all races, across the country, killed by police because the person is not acting rationally or as the police or community expects. My heart breaks with each report, and my worst fear is that my own son will be killed while in crisis. I see my son in each video I watch of some person in crisis being killed.

The reasons for disastrous police interactions with persons in crisis, nationwide, are complex. To try to understand the police perspective better, I attended the BPD Community Academy while I was on the Board of Directors for NAMI VT, and a member of the MH/police subcommittee. I have researched this issue and how it is handled in numerous other states. I was a member of a working group at BPD for mental health outreach, prior to the pandemic. More recently I have coordinated and attended meetings with the BPD and Pathways Vermont to increase communication and engagement. I have given testimony numerous times to the Burlington Police Commission and the State legislature regarding mental health issues. As an attorney and mathematician I am able to bring an analysis of data and facts to reach a more concrete overall picture.

I believe I can bring a valuable perspective to the Police Commission, and I would cherish this opportunity to serve.

Additional Comments

Since I was appointed a Commissioner at the beginning of May, I have immersed myself in the work of the Commission. I am currently preparing a plan for further review and refinement of DD13.2 and 13.3, and have enlisted reviewers from Pathways Vermont, the Vermont Mental Health Law Project, NAMI VT, Another Way, and have renewed the connection with the E.D. of Disability Rights Vermont for review of both Directives.

I am also working on a plan for a working group, with Commissioners and BPD officers and staff, to consider the topic of handcuffs and physical restraint of persons in crisis (including but not limited to mental health crises). Acting Chief Murad agreed to a working group approach, including officers who actually respond to people in crisis, at the May Commission meeting when I raised the issue.

I reviewed most of the Use of Force reports and bodycam footage from the month previous to my appointment, so that I could participate in discussions I have been assigned Use of Force incidents from the May report. On May 18, I attended the NACOLE webinar on bias in the viewing of bodycam footage, which gave me important insights to this work.

In line with one of the CNA recommendations, I suggested during the Commission's May meeting that the BPD use Public Information, posted to social media, Front Porch Forum, etc., to reach out to the community regarding things like the Priority Response Plan, and other things that the police do on a daily basis. I have a coffee meeting set up with the BPD Public Information Officer for June 1 to discuss her work and how it might be expanded to attract more viewers and provide more Department transparency.

I am also registered for the May 7 NACOLE Webinar on Force in effecting arrests.

Finally, I am working on an outreach plan, and have met with two community members who had some excellent suggestions for increasing the Commission's engagement with the community. I look forward to developing this plan further.
