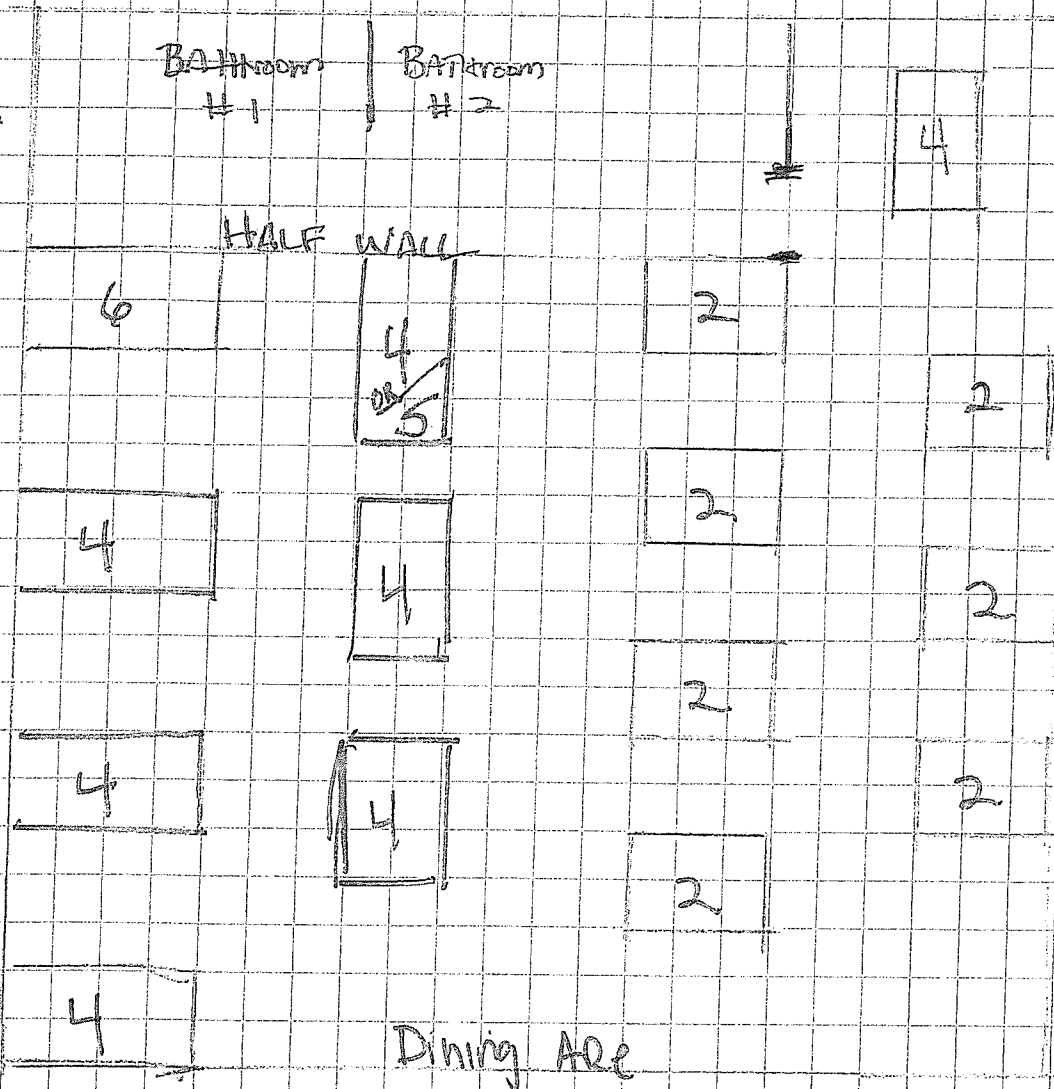

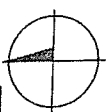


PROPOSED OCCUPANT LOAD

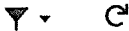

1. Have you ever had a liquor license before? If yes, please explain.

2. Please describe your experience serving or selling alcohol?

We have all served alcohol throughout our careers. Louie has the most experience and has managed a bar in California called Sandy's Pub. The extent of Max's experience is in the catering world as he served alcohol for local catering companies throughout college and then in Boston for high-end catering companies throughout the city. Tyson has worked in the service industry for years, mostly working at high-end restaurants in Massachusetts (Boston and Martha's Vineyard).

3. Are you familiar with the laws relating to the sale of alcohol in Vermont? Have you completed the training required by DLC? Have your employees? If not, what is your plan for training?

We are planning on taking all courses offered by the State of Vermont and passing all seminars and related quizzes. We will train all of our servers through these same resources.

4. Have you had an opportunity to meet with an inspector from the Department of Liquor Control?

Yes, we met with Matt Gonyo in the past and then most recently we met with David Hamlin, who we believe is Matt's replacement at the DLC. We took him on a tour through the space and the outdoor area.

5. How many employees will you have?

These numbers are not solidified yet, but following the formula that worked for Arts Riot last summer, we hope to hire at least 10-15 employees to successfully run the Friday Night food truck event.

6. What is/will the square footage of the public space and what is/will be your occupancy load??

There are two distinct scenarios to consider — 1) Friday night food trucks taking up the entire parking lot of the Coal Collective. This will have a maximum occupancy of 999 customers at one time. 2) On any other normal day, our secured area will be closer to 3000 square feet. We are working with Burlington's Assistant Fire Marshal, Phil Edgerley, to provide a safe occupancy load for this smaller area.

7. What kind of precautions will you take to prevent underage sales?

On Friday night's with the food trucks, we already have Chocolate Thunders scheduled to run security and check ID's for the event. During the quieter days we will require our bar staff to be highly trained and inspecting people's IDs before any service takes place.
