They would like to continue having music on their front patio next. He states that the fight that Bushnell mentioned in her public comment had nothing to do with their business and that last call was always issued at 10:45pm during the city council mandated 11pm closing time.

Stromberg expressed her frustration that there has been another sworn complaint and feels a public hearing is appropriate.
