Introductions:

- Plans for new Police Chief, Brandon del Pozo to attend December NPA: proposal to start at 6:45 pm.

City Council Update (Sharon Foley Bushor and Adam Roof):

- Concerns stated about the increased height and density proposal.
- Lake Monsters request to construct a small retail building.
- Urban agriculture passed: chickens, rabbits, goats and sheep allowed in limited numbers.
- Housing Action Plan: funding raised to prioritize affordable housing.
- Neighborhood Noise Initiative:
 - 494 calls city wide regarding noise.
 - Trying to identify ways to hold landlords accountable: police calling landlord, encouraging landlord to call parents of students, etc...

City LEAD Initiative (Lauren Pyatt):

- Using HUD grant to provide services and fix lead problems in Burlington and Winooski at an average of \$8000/unit.

Speak Out:

- Community members voice concerns about housing and sidewalk repair.

Update from Patrick O'brien on SD Ireland Grove St. Project

- In the phase of "construction documents."
- Has not defined a specific target market.
- Has received permit to include a community center.

- All streets within will be private.
- At least one Car Share VT unit will be included.
- Community members voice concerns of traffic density due to increased housing.
