Resident: Has 2 records of Orlando's outdoor entertainment showing exceeding permitted hours of operations was last Wednesday night, music was loud on Thursday 10:38 pm. It's her 3rd time to come before the committee to ask that something be done to make Orlando's run their business within the permitted house of operations. Last couple month's Orlando violated their permitted hours of operations. The resident feels frustrated and needs Orlando to stop violating their permits.

JS: Will go to committee discussion regarding this item. JS went down to Orlando and witnessed their violation herself. It's a chronic problem and we consulted our attorney to advise us on actions we can take.

HM: Actions can be taken:

1. Stop their entertainment permit.
2. Shortening their hours of operations
3. Add more conditions to their permit/license
