3.01 Outdoor Entertainment Permit Application (2017-2018): Dedalus Wine Group, 388 Pine Street

3.02 Special Event Outdoor Entertainment Permit Application approve (three days only): SEABA, Art Hop, Friday - Sunday, September 8 - 10, 2017

AB stated that this is the sixth year of running this event. Last year was the first year doing the street closure which was between Howard Street and Marble Avenue starting at 5pm and reopening at 10pm. This year, closing Howard to Kilburn, based on BPD recommendations. BPD will be doing traffic control and the times will be changing to 6pm to 10pm possibly a little later. This change is to give people more time as they leave work to clear Pine Street. AB stated that opening the street back up after the event was more difficult than they anticipated last year. Arts Riot is going to be more involved in controlling their outside area this year to help in the safety measures of the event. Secure parking will be provided and shuttles will be provided for people to and from the event. LO asked that AB be in touch regarding any of the smaller venues in the area being occupied by too many people as a few years back this became an issue with the Fire Marshal. AR stated that under Part 3 description it reads "TBD" and states this will bring too much attention and questions. AB wants to direct traffic to all areas of the Art Hop event and Flynn Avenue is one area that doesn't get as much foot traffic on Friday night. Select Design has been involved but LO has asked to take this part out as it will cause major concerns. LO stated that if anything does end up happening at Switchback or Select Design, they will have to fill out proper paperwork before

event. AB stated that this year's attendance will reach approximately 30 to 35,000 people (similar to last year). DLC and health department will be there to conduct proper inspections.

3.03 Special Event Outdoor Entertainment Permit Application approve (three days only): Burlington City Arts, Festival of Fools, August 4 - 6, 2017, Friday – Sunday

ZW stated this is his third year with the event where it mostly takes place on Church Street and City Hall Park. This year the event is looking to expand which leads to three special event permits. The City Hall Park application on Saturday needs to be amended to go from 6 to 9 pm. An additional change to be made on the Bank Street application where the streets do not need to be closed down on Sunday and Saturday hours have been reduced to 1pm to 9pm. On Friday, regarding Main Street, the event is working with Nectars to close traffic at 1 pm with a mobile stage and sound system for a New Orleans street party from 5pm to 8:30 pm with a bar via Nectar's. Saturday mobile stage via City Hall Park during Farmers Market and in the evening with a bar for just evening hours. Saturday, during the day, Bank Street closed for a performance zone. Security is hired during peak hours to help with flow of people traffic.

3.04 Special Event Outdoor Entertainment Permit Application approve (one day only): Nectar's, Block Party on Main Street, Saturday, September 2, 2017, 7:00 am - 11:00 pm

BM stated that this is the second year of the event to celebrate the band Madaila. Public portion of event opens at noon. Music is from 2 to 9pm and street will open again by 11pm. The audience then moves inside to Nectar's for after party. LO inquired about hours and 7 am is correct to close street down properly. No entertainment is happening at 7 am, will be starting roughly at noon. LO suggests changing the time from 12pm to 9pm to just cover entertainment times. Street will still be closed 7am to 11pm. LO asked about poor weather conditions and BM stated it will be a rain or shine event.
