- **ALL** property adjacent to any property (in or outside the Buffer Zone) being treated must be notified no more than 10 days before application, but no less than 24 hours before application.
- There must be two postings per property or 1 posting every 100 feet. Signs posted must meet specifications required in City of Burlington Municipal Ordinance Sec. 17-9(d) (see other side of form).

Description of the area and the problem to be treated: Treat a single Ash tree on property with an injected systemic insecticide to prevent infestation by Emerald Ash borer  
What alternatives to pesticides/herbicides have been tried? None available
