1.0 CALL TO ORDER and AGENDA

1.01 Agenda

3.01 First Class Restaurant/Bar Liquor License Application 2019-2020: Shacksbury, LLC d/b/a CO Cellars, 266 Pine Street

MOTION by Councilor Roof, SECOND by Councilor Tracy, to approve the First Class Restaurant/Bar Liquor License Application 2019-2020 for Shacksbury, LLC d/b/a CO Cellars, 266 Pine Street contingent upon Fire Marshall approval with all standard conditions.

DISCUSSION:

- Councilor Bushor asked if the establishment is a restaurant or bar. Councilor Roof said the establishment meets the requirements of offering food, but is not necessarily a restaurant. Councilor Tracy said snacks and light fare will be offered.

MOTION by Councilor Roof, SECOND by Councilor Tracy, to approve the Outside Consumption Permit Application 2019-2020 for Shacksbury, LLC d/b/a CO Cellars, 266 Pine Street. VOTING: unanimous; motion carried.

3.03 Outside Consumption Permit Application 2019-2020: Pho Son, 213 College Street

MOTION by Councilor Roof, SECOND by Councilor Tracy, to approve the Outside Consumption Permit Application 2019-2020 for Pho Son, 213 College Street, for a total of six seats, 11 AM to 9 PM daily. VOTING: unanimous; motion carried.

3.04 Outside Consumption Permit Application (Parklet): The Archives, 191 College Street

MOTION by Councilor Roof, SECOND by Councilor Tracy, to approve the Outside Consumption Permit Application for a parklet with a maximum of eight seats terminating October 1, 2019 for The Archives at 191 College Street, Monday through Friday, 4 PM to 2 AM, Saturday and Sunday, 12 PM to 2 AM.

DISCUSSION:

- Councilor Bushor commented positively on the design.



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- Mayor Weinberger noted this is one of the first parklet applications. The design is very innovative.

VOTING: unanimous; motion carried.

3.06 Outside Consumption Permit Application (Parklet): Restaurant Poco, 55 Main Street

MOTION by Councilor Roof, SECOND by Councilor Tracy, to approve the Outside Consumption Permit Application for a parklet at Restaurant Poco, 55 Main Street, with up to 20 seats from June through October 2019, 11 AM – 11 PM, Tuesday through Saturday. VOTING: unanimous; motion carried.
