1. Review of the CJC's Budget: review, input, next steps

The CAC membership discussed that the CJC's budget was projected to be balanced for FY15.

2. Update on Graffiti Removal Position transition: check-in to make sure CJC and community interests still in play

Graffiti Removal position will be transitioned to CODE Enforcement as soon into FY15 as is conceivable. The CJC's programmatic interests: victim support, offender accountability, volunteer opportunities and community safety are all considered in the job description.
