Olberg confirmed that there is no formal policy concerning the hours of liquor sales. Shannon asked if liquor could be sold 24 hours a day. Mason explained that the committee can license for more restrictive hours, but there is a state level restriction that requires liquor sales to stop at 2am. Shannon asked that the chair set some time aside to potentially develop this policy, and Mason confirmed it could be added to the agenda at the next meeting. Hanson commented that the hours of retail sales are rarely altered, but bar/restaurant service has been altered by the committee.
