### **2. planBTV- Municipal Development Plan Update**

The Committee discussed the proposed framework for organizing the updated planBTV, and the synthesis of the plan into a series of themes.

- Find a way to make the overall vision statement more clear about core city within the region, and that the 4 themes are Burlington's values.
- "Sustainable" is a difficult, overused word, but might be best term for this purpose, especially since the text that follows is more descriptive of what it means
- Make the Dynamic statement more positive and forward looking.
- In Distinctive, talk more about Burlington's natural setting and assets, historic building stock, and diverse culture.
- In Inclusive, make sure education is part of this, and talk about recognizing different cultures in public art/public spaces.
- For each theme, try to describe the city's character first, then talk about the land use patterns and development priorities that are consistent with/support that character.
- Throughout, eliminate passive voice and be more direct.
