Matthew Mantone, owner, would like to have an indoor entertainment permit application even though he does not have or want a liquor license. His business is a theater, performance, yoga space and sometimes has entertainment until late. There have been noise complaints by an individual who works (lives) in the building. The application will not protect him from noise violations if the Police are called (per Shawn Burke, Police has to respond to all complaints). The Committee commented that this seems to be an issue that can hopefully be settled between tenants. The Committee recommended that this application be approved, Matthew Mantone was told to come into the C/T Office the next day to fill out the proper form, check off all types of entertainment and submit a check for \$100 made payable to the City of Burlington. This application will be part of the February 9, 2015 City Council Agenda.

4.03 Bento, peddler hour end time: 3 a.m., request from owner, Chris Russo. Shawn Burke was not in favor of the 3 a.m. hour from a public safety concern. At that hour, the four blocks downtown are managed by officers who are working and have enough to worry about without adding other possible problems. He and the owner agreed to 1 a.m. with the Committee allowing this to occur until the end of the licensing year, May 30, 2015. The change will be treated as a housekeeping item with the C/T Office amending his license. 11 a.m. - 1 a.m., everyday.
