AR: Will proceed through the Ordinance as referred and it is my understanding that Mr. Marshall is circulating copies of a further amendment of that ordinance which he would like the committee to consider.

SteveM: walks the committee through his proposed ordinance changes

Chief BdP: discusses measures that BPD has taken historically to address the underlying issues of public urination and public defecation.

Chief BPD presents spreadsheet of ticket issuance over time. 2017 presents as the year of the lowest issuance of tickets over the past five years.

MT – comments on his ordinance changes which were reflected in the material posted for the meeting. His changes were focused on addressing problems in the Downtown core, but he acknowledges problems in the residential neighborhoods located off of downtown.

Would request BPD explore possibilities for notice of nearest public bathroom when issuing ticket for public urination or public defecation?
